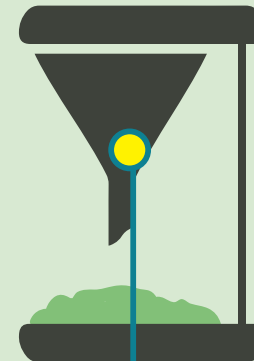

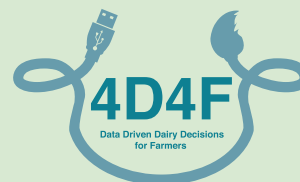


AUTOMATIC FEEDING
